

Commercial Road Test Bookings Guide

The information below was provided by Alberta Transportation for Albertans requiring assistance with scheduling commercial road tests in order to comply with Mandatory Entry-Level Training (MELT) for Class 1 driver's licenses. It consists of common questions and a step-by-step guide to online booking including screenshots of each step.

Q: How can I book my Class 1 road test?

1. Ensure you are eligible
2. Pay any outstanding fines
3. Book your road test
 - online through the Alberta Road Test Scheduler <https://scheduler.italb4dmv.com/schAlberta> (see below for steps to walk you through the online booking process)
 - in-person at an Alberta registry agent

Q. How do I use the online site?

Note: The commercial Class 1 list provided includes all the current Class 1 Mandatory Entry Level Training (MELT) “approved” public sites. Many Class 1 driving schools have had their private lots approved to have testing at their locations for their students only (and are not on this list). There are over 40 of these schools across the province. A challenge Transportation often faces is identifying suitable road public test lots to do MELT testing from that have the necessary infrastructure to meet MELT requirements. Rural areas are often more challenging due to the lack of transportation infrastructure. Transportation asks students to contact the Driver Examinations email address at commercialroadtests@gov.ab.ca and the team will work to organize around the requests received.
